

HAMMAR LIFEBUOY RELEASE SYSTEM

Scope: The difference between life and death when someone goes overboard from a ship or vessel can be the time it takes to launch a lifebuoy to the person in the sea. Most lifebuoys nowadays are fitted in a holder on the bridge wing or in similar remote areas, where quick access takes some time to reach.

Solution: C M Hammar has now developed an easy to fit complete package for rapid launch of the lifebuoys onboard a ship. The system consists of:

- * One Solas approved lifebuoy
- * One GRP holder for the lifebuoy
- * One Hammar electric remote unit (ERU) that holds the buoy in position and features remote activation from the bridge and a manual backup at the lifebuoy holder
- * One Hammar ERRS release switch for remote activation
- * Supplied with electric connector box, cable, GRP-holder fittings, mounting instructions.

Features:

- * Safe and quick operation to save lives
- * Electric remote unit removed after activation with strong spring
- * One complete package
- * Easy installation
- * Economical solution
